Directions to Western Hills Golf Course

From Northern and Southern Connecticut

Follow Route 8 towards Waterbury to I-84 West. Take exit 18 and bear left at the fork in the exit ramp.

Continue straight through the traffic light onto Park Road. Follow Park Road until you reach the Western Hills Golf Course. Turn right into golf course.

From Eastern Connecticut

Follow I-84 West. Take exit 18 and bear left at the fork in the exit ramp. Continue straight through the traffic light onto Park Road. Follow Park Road until you reach the Western Hills Golf Course. Turn right into golf course.

From Western Connecticut

Follow I-84 East to Exit 17. At the bottom of the exit, turn left onto Route 63. Follow Route 63 until you come to the 3rd traffic light and make a right turn onto Park Road. Follow Park Road to stop sign. Take a left at the stop sign into the golf course.

Tournament Information

- Shotgun start outings are available Monday through Friday before Labor Day and Monday through Sunday after Labor Day. We allow the course to be closed for only one weekday and one weekend outing per week. All shotgun starts must start at 8 am. No outings will be allowed on holidays.

- **The minimum number of players required for a weekday tournament is 72 and the minimum for a weekend tournament is 80.** The maximum number of players allowed for an event is 144 participants.

- **Fees**
 - Weekday tournament fees are \$50 per player for green fees and cart. Any weekday tournaments with 100 players or more will receive a \$5 discount and be charged \$45 per player.
 - Weekend tournament fees are \$55 per player for green fees and cart. Any weekend tournaments with 100 players or more will receive a \$5 discount and be charged \$50 per player.
 - The amount of \$7 per participant must be spent in the pro shop for prizes – 72 golfer minimum on weekdays and 80 minimum on weekends.
 - Restaurant fees vary depending on the package you choose. Tournaments are required to pay for a minimum of 72 on weekdays and 80 on the weekends. Contact the restaurant manager for more info.
 - A \$500 deposit is required for all events. The deposit is **NON-REFUNDABLE** and is required to hold the date.

Rules and Regulations

- Appropriate golf attire is required for all participants and tournament staff.
- The tournament director is responsible for the conduct of the event participants and event staff. The tournament director is liable for damages to persons/person, the facility, and or equipment/golf carts as it relates to improper behavior. Damages will be billed to the tournament/tournament director as warranted.
- **No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the course unless they are purchased from the restaurant.**
- Any special tournament requests must be given to the golf professional at least 7 days in advance.
- 7 days prior to the event you must declare the number of participants so that the food can be ordered and that the appropriate number of carts are on hand.
- The balance of the course fees must be paid at least 7 days in advance. Pro shop fees and restaurant fees are due in full on the day of the event.
- Pace of play expectations for all outings is 4 hours and 30 minutes.

In the event of inclement weather, the tournament will start unless the course is deemed unplayable by the golf course staff.
